1. Membership categories

- 2) Individual membership of NACOS includes any HCP, researcher, or policy maker with an interest in clinical obesity services/care.

2. Membership application and approval process

- b. The President will review and approve all applications that clearly meet the above criteria. Where there is any uncertainty, he/she will seek advice from any other another Committee member.
